A statement from Cllr Peter Chowney

Soon, it'll be that time again: the council elections. This year, it'll be me who's up for election. So here's a few things I've done since you first elected me in 2006.

I'm currently the council's Lead Member for Regeneration. In this role, I've led on projects such as getting Saga into town to provide 700 new jobs, helping the pier trust to

secure a £7.5m lottery grant, and leading the 'Grotbuster' project to improve over 500 properties. In Tressell, along with Jay Kramer, I've worked with residents to get the Ore Valley Adventure Playground, traffic lights at the Sussex Arms junction, and campaigning to protect open space at Speckled Wood. I've also represented local people on a range of difficult planning issues, and carried out regular estate inspections with Amicus Horizon housing association to make sure social housing is properly maintained.

As we get nearer the election, I'll be telling you more about my promises for the next four years. For now, I promise I'll continue to do my best to regenerate Hastings, and to fight for the interests of the people of Tressell ward.
